

Covid-19 Policy School Year 2022-2023 (Updated 9/19/2022)

Please complete the COVID-19 Student Symptom/Exposure Reporting Form if applicable.

Collier schools will adhere to the following policies regarding students and staff who test positive for Covid-19, who have had exposure to individuals who have tested positive for Covid and/or are exhibiting Covid-19 compatible symptoms.

Covid compatible Symptoms:

If a student or staff member are experiencing **2 or more** of the following symptoms they should remain at home and be tested for Covid 19 (Especially if they have had a known exposure to someone who has tested positive for Covid - Home tests are acceptable) and/or receive an alternate, documented diagnosis from their healthcare provider:

Feverish, Chills, Muscle aches, Headache, Sore Throat, Nausea/Vomiting, Diarrhea, Fatigue, Congestion and/or runny nose.

If a student or staff member are experiencing **1** of the following symptoms they should remain at home and be tested for Covid 19 and/or receive an alternate, documented diagnosis from their healthcare provider: Fever, Cough, Shortness of Breath, Difficulty Breathing, New Loss of Taste, New Loss of Smell

Isolation Policy

Any student and/or staff who tests positive for Covid-19, has Covid-19 compatible symptoms who has not been tested (and does not have an alternate diagnosis from their healthcare provider) should isolate for 5 days before returning to school and may return to school on day 6 with proof of a negative Covid test. Students or staff upon return on day 6 must wear a mask on days 6-10. When testing positive for Covid, the day of the test is considered day 0, the 5 day period begins the day after the test is taken.
